The Sacramento Area Chapter of AACN (SAC-AACN) actively engages our community by empowering individuals to respond effectively to emergencies. We taught hands-only CPR to market-goers at our local farmers' market. We led the STOP THE BLEED campaign to help our community recognize life-threatening bleeding and appropriate interventions. Additionally, our nurses assisted with free youth heart screenings coordinated by the Kyle J. Taylor Foundation, Project Adam and UC Davis Health. Nearly 700 area youths were screened for cardiac anomalies that could potentially cause sudden cardiac arrest. We also contributed \$1,000 to local food banks and \$1,180 to Julie's Purse Project, a local organization that donates purses filled with essential items to women in need. The members of SAC-AACN continue to rise together to serve our community through our contributions to public service and community education.
